OPGS is offering two days of Sixth Form study to our applicants. You will follow your subject timetable as when you join us in September. This will include free time and study periods, as well as Sixth Form briefing and lessons with your subject teachers. Students are expected in for both days to ensure they experience all their lessons.

Timetable

All students are required to come into school at 8.40am on Thursday 22nd June. You will collect your timetable, be welcomed by The Sixth Form Team and get to know the other students who will be joining you in Year 12.

After this session, you will follow your chosen subject timetable for the rest of the day. You will do one or more lessons over the two days each of your four subjects. For most students, this will mean attending lessons in their three chosen subjects, and their reserve subject. Where you are not required in a lesson, you will be assigned a study room where you can work on the Taster Activities set by staff.

On 22nd June, the day will run from 8.40am to 3.25pm. Lunch will run from 1.10pm to 2.20pm.

All students are allowed to leave the site at lunch to buy food from local outlets. You may wish to bring your own food. Current OPGS students can use their fobs to buy food from the canteen.

On 23rd June, students are only required in for their first timetabled lesson. However, students are welcome to come in at 8.40am and study until their classes begin. On 23rd June, all students will leave at 1.10pm.


Dress Code

OPGS Sixth Form has a formal dress code. Please see our website or click on the link:


