

Homework Timetable

Year 9

Completing homework and extending learning into the home offers students many benefits. Homework should support students in mastering information learned at school and allow them to revisit important knowledge, boosting memory retention.

A homework timetable will support our learners as they progress through the keystone year of the curriculum and should allow them to continue to develop and embed the time management skills and resilience they have developed towards independent study in the foundation years. It will also support parents and carers to help their children in organising their workload at home and contribute to ensuring all of our learners are ready to begin their GCSEs.

Teachers at Oakwood Park Grammar School commit to setting homework that offers purpose to learning and will ensure that all work set will support learners in developing and mastering the knowledge, skills and understanding required to be successful in their subject areas.

Homework will be set on EduLink but is likely to take a variety of forms. It will range from consolidating learning through the completion of an extended piece of writing to quick fire or multiple choice questions on a learning platform. Not all homework will be explicitly marked but students should receive feedback.

We advise that homework should not be set for the following day but understand there may be rare occasions where a member of staff feels it necessary.
